Who is this program for?

The Specialist Intervention Family Preservation and Reunification Response program aims to help children and families stay together safely at home. Delivered throughout Inner Gippsland it works with young people aged 10 to 17 years who are at risk of entering the Out of Home Care system or returning to the family home for reunification.

Referral Pathway

The Specialist Intervention Family Preservation and Reunification Response is available by referral only from the Department of Families, Fairness and Housing. Families and young people must consent to a referral being made to the service. Referrals are connected to Quantum Support Services by the Child Protection Navigator Practitioner.

How can it assist?

Support a young person to develop their goals and ways to achieve them

Support positive relationships and communication

Provide support to young people, their families and/or carers to maintain long term stable care

Guide young people and their families to agree on rules and expectations

Support young people to access school, training programs or find employment

Provide information and advice in where to access other community supports and social and recreational activities

Specialist Intervention Family Preservation and Reunification Response

The Family Preservation and Reunification Response is a partnership of agencies in Inner Gippsland. The Family Preservation and Reunification Response aims to work with families to improve safety, wellbeing and development of children, prevent children entering care and work towards reunification for those currently in care.

The Family Preservation and Reunification Response provides a range of services dependent on a family's needs including:

Provide one-on-one support to the young person and their parents/carers

Talk with the young person's family/carers about what's going on or have a family meeting

Support the young person to work through issues that are affecting their relationships

Support the young person to stay living with their family or if they live apart, how to have a positive relationship with one another

Support the young person to understand their feelings on certain issues

Help the young person's family understand how the young person feels and why

Link the young person into community support services

Meet with the young person's school and let them know how they can best support

Help the young person find an alternative training program if school isn't working for them

Support the young person to engage in activities that make them feel positive and inspired about life
